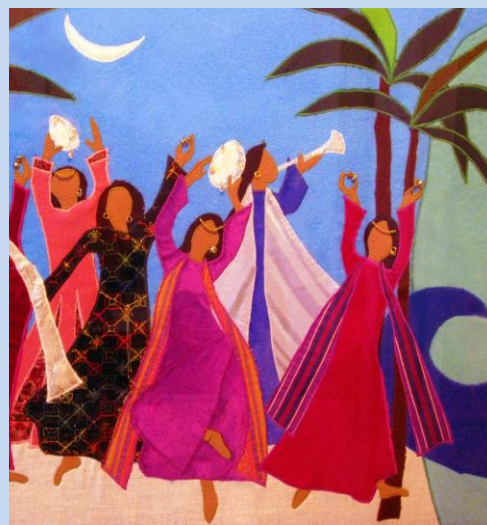


Congregation Etz Chaim's Sisterhood invites you to our 3rd annual
